



Their friend Dr. Giraffe says, "A budget will help."


"What is a budget?" they ask.

"A budget is a plan of how you will spend your money," he says.

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
#### Need? Want?

Zayn tells Dr Giraffe that his family spent money on lots of things. "But when I ask for a new toy they often say no. They say that they don't have money for it. Why do they have money for some things, but not for the toys I want?" he asks.

Dr Giraffe says, "Some things we NEED, or have to have. Some things we WANT, but don't have to have. Your family has to spend money on things they need first. Then they can see what else they can buy."





# A Trip to the Shop

Dr Giraffe, Layla, and Zayn go to the shop to buy the food for the cake. They also learn about how shops try to get us to buy things.

Dr Giraffe gets a trolley. "See how big it is? The more space we have to put food in, the more money we can spend!"

He asks Layla and Zayn to find milk and eggs. They look all over. Along the way they see sweets, cakes, and toys. Dr Giraffe says shops often put the things we NEED, like milk and eggs, around the back or sides. Then we have to pass things we WANT, but don't need, to get to them.

In the shop Dr Giraffe sees a treat he likes -



There are lots of brands, or makes. Some are cheaper than others. He shows Layla and Zayn that the cheapest are on the lowest shelves. The Jaffa Cakes that cost the most are higher—"so we see them first! By bending down we can save money." He says that store brands often cost less, but taste almost the same. "In fact," he says, "I like them better!"



## pit about Money

Dr Giraffe helps Zayn and Layla bake the cake. While they bake, he tells them about money.

"Money has been around for 3000 years. It has been many shapes and sizes, from coins to notes and even shells. Before money, people traded things," he says.









Are the people smiling?







Help Zayn get to the savings jar while picking up as many coins as you can!





### Fun money facts

The place where coins are made in the UK is called the Royal Mint

More money is made for the game MONOPOLY than real money is made around the world



Roman soldiers were paid with blocks of salt

People used to save money in clay, or PYGG, jars. Later people then made them shaped like a pig for fun

Old bank notes that are torn or dirty are made into bricks, then burnt. This can be up to £11 billion a year

On the edge of the old £1 COINS its says 'Standing on the shoulders of giants'

When you put together new 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, and 50p coins, they make up the Royal Shield of the UK
