

Quaker Social Action Terms & Conditions

2022 RideLondon-Essex 100 Charity Place

1. Before applying for this event, you should be fit to participate. If you are unsure about this in any way, you should seek medical advice. Quaker Social Action shall not be held responsible for any injury or illness that may be caused as a result of the event.
2. You understand that it is your responsibility to read any terms and conditions issued by the event organisers and to comply with these.
3. You must be 18 years or over on the day of the 2022 RideLondon-Essex 100, 29 May 2022.
4. If accepted to ride for Quaker Social Action you will be asked to pay a registration fee of £35. The registration fee is non-refundable and it cannot be used towards your sponsorship pledge.
5. You acknowledge this is a fundraising event and pledge to raise the minimum sponsorship promise of £600, excluding Gift Aid, and pay this to Quaker Social Action no later than 29 June 2022.
6. The money raised through the event for Quaker Social Action is unrestricted.
7. If the 2022 RideLondon-Essex 100 is cancelled for any reason, either by the organiser London Marathon Events or on the advice or instruction of the Government, then we will adopt and follow the advice that will be subsequently given by the organisers, keeping you informed and updated at each stage of the proceedings.
8. Should you need to withdraw for any reason, you acknowledge that you will contact Quaker Social Action immediately.
9. If you withdraw or the event is cancelled, you are responsible for contacting your sponsors to inform them that you are no longer taking part and for confirming with them whether they are happy for the money they have donated to still be given to Quaker Social Action.
10. You acknowledge that you must only use lawful means to fundraise for the charity and must not do anything which harms, or is likely to harm the charity's reputation.
11. You acknowledge that Quaker Social Action's Charity Place has a cost to Quaker Social Action.
12. You acknowledge that you will be contacted by email, phone and post in relation to the 2022 RideLondon-Essex 100 to ensure Quaker Social Action can provide the necessary administration and communication required to complete your successful participation in the event.
13. The information you provide in your application will be treated confidentially and in line with our [Privacy Policy](#). We will need to share your details with the organiser London Marathon Events in order to register your place.
14. You acknowledge that by accepting the Charity Place, you consent to Quaker Social Action using photographs and video footage of you from 2022 RideLondon-Essex 100 in promotional materials for publicising future events and the work of the charity, examples include our website and social media.
