

## Quaker Social Action Terms & Conditions

### Virgin Money London Marathon 2021 Guaranteed/Charity Place

1. Before registering for this event, you should be fit to participate. If you are unsure about this in any way, you should seek medical advice. You should inform Quaker Social Action and the event organisers of any pre-existing medical conditions, as well as any that arise after registration, that may affect your participation.
2. You understand that it is your responsibility to read any terms and conditions issued by the event organisers and to comply with these.
3. You must be 18 years or over on the day of the Marathon, Sunday 3rd October 2021.
4. If accepted to run for Quaker Social Action you will be asked to pay a registration fee of £100. The registration fee is non-refundable and it cannot be used towards your sponsorship pledge.
5. You acknowledge this is a fundraising event and pledge to raise the minimum sponsorship promise of £2,000, excluding Gift Aid, and pay this to Quaker Social Action no later than 3rd November 2021.
6. The money raised through the event for Quaker Social Action is unrestricted.
7. Should you need to withdraw for any reason, you acknowledge that you will contact Quaker Social Action immediately. Your place will not automatically defer to the 2022 London Marathon. You will send all sponsorship forms and money collected directly to Quaker Social Action and notify your sponsors that you are no longer taking part. Any sponsorship monies to be refunded can only be processed on the written request of the sponsor to Quaker Social Action and will be refunded directly to that sponsor, not the participant.
8. If the London Marathon is cancelled for any reason, either by London Marathon Events or on the advice or instruction of the Government, then we will adopt and follow the advice that will be subsequently given by the London Marathon, keeping you informed and updated at each stage of the proceedings.
9. You acknowledge that you must only use lawful means to fundraise for the charity and must not do anything which harms, or is likely to harm the charity's reputation.
10. You acknowledge that Quaker Social Action's Charity Place has a cost to Quaker Social Action.
11. You acknowledge that you will be contacted by email, phone and post in relation to the London Marathon to ensure Quaker Social Action can provide the necessary administration and communication required to complete your successful participation in the event.
12. The information you provide in your application will be treated confidentially and in line with our [Privacy Policy](#). We will need to share your details with London Marathon Events in order to register your place.

You acknowledge that by accepting the Charity Place, you consent to Quaker Social Action using photographs and video footage of you from training days and marathon day in promotional materials for publicising future events and the work of the charity, examples include our website and social media.
