Total amount of money you get **before** taxes or other deductions are subtracted from your **salary**.

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A unique **number** used in the United Kingdom to allow you to work in the UK.

Money that an individual or business receives in exchange for providing a good or service.

A form of **tax** you pay on your income. Helps pay for public services such as NHS or welfare system.

A form of **tax** paid by workers towards the cost of certain state benefits e.g. Pension or Maternity Allowance.

A code used by your employer to work out how much Income Tax to take from your pay.

This is the amount of money you're entitled to before you start paying income tax – currently £11,000.

This is something you take away from your income/salary which includes Student Finance, Tax & Pension.
